CALL FOR PROPOSALS:

Black women have consistently participated in everyday acts of resistance, organized protest, and more. As black women's activism has transformed, similarities have also emerged across space and time. The UC Women's Center invites proposals from students, faculty, staff, and the greater Cincinnati community for workshops, roundtable discussions, and works in progress presentations that will explore the diverse meanings of black feminism.
